

## **CABIN CREW CONVERSION AND DIFFERENCES TRAINING AIRBUS 319/320**

### **COURSE OBJECTIVE**

In accordance with ORO.CC.125 and ORO.CC.130 Subpart Cabin Crew, "Cabin Crew Conversion and Differences Training Airbus n319/320 shall be applied to:

- Cabin crew after successfully finished Initial Safety Training;
- All current Cabin crew members if new variant has different safety equipment and/or safety equipment location;
- Conversion and differences training will also be used for re-qualification of cabin crew members who are not current on type.

This course has been designed to provide applicants training which includes the use of all safety equipment and all applicable normal and emergency procedures. It also includes training and practice on a representative training device.

### **QUALIFICATION AND EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS**

All applicants undertaking the "Conversion and Differences Training Airbus 319/320" must successfully finished Initial Safety Training and must hold an attestation.

### **CREDIT FOR PREVIOUS EXPERIENCE**

All applicants with previous experience may be credited for the following modules when undergoing training at Croatia Airlines:

- Aircraft visit,
- Familiarization flights,
- Valid Mock-up training - Lufthansa Training Certificate
